Date: April 2, 2023 - Luke 19-22

Central Idea: Even in our darkest hour or week God's plan and purpose comes through in the end. Are you letting your season stop the chance to let God's plan unfold?

Introduction: During Jesus's last week before his death on the cross it started with Him entering into Jerusalem on a colt. Jesus was making waves and the storm was brewing through the Pharisees.
