Sermon Title: "HOW WELL DOES GOD KNOW ME?"

Date: July 9, 2023 - Psalm 139:1-6

<u>Central Idea:</u> God knows our every thought, every word, and every move. Is there something in your life that needs to change?

Introduction:

The psalmist was a man who knew and loved God. God is referred to by name six times and by personal pronoun thirty times. The psalmist refers to himself fifty times. This is a song of profound spiritual experience. All such experience is personal and intimate—the engagement of a soul with God.

David contemplated God and wrote for us a psalm whose message can only encourage us to be in a right relationship with Him.

Verses 1-6 remind us that God knows everything we do. He knows you personally and intimately, so do not try to fool Him! Be open and honest with God and rest in His love. His eye is upon you, and you have nothing to fear.

We should be overwhelmed by the height and depth of God's knowledge and be thankful that He knows us perfectly. We cannot deceive God. He knows us intimately. Is there something in your life that needs to change?
