Sermon Title:"HOW CLOSE IS GOD TO ME?"

Date: July 14, 2023 - Psalm 139:7-12

Central Idea: God is with us constantly—we cannot escape Him. Are you aware of God's presence?

Introduction:

If God knows so much about us, perhaps the wisest thing is to run away and hide, but all "escape routes" are futile. God is omnipresent—everywhere present. He knows where you go. What a comfort to know that God is with you and cares for you! Whether you go up or down, east or west, He is there. God promised in Hebrews 13:5, "I will never leave you nor forsake you." Sinners try to hide from God, but believers hide in God. Not only does God know who we are, but He knows where we are.
