## Sermon Title: "MEETING IN THE MARKETPLACE" Date: October 22, 2023 - Acts 17:16-21

<u>Central Idea:</u> When witnessing, make your way as quickly as possible to Jesus and the resurrection. Are you sharing Jesus?

<u>Introduction:</u> Paul now moved into the capital city of Athens. He was greatly impressed, not by the wonderful buildings, not by the art, not by the philosophy, but by the idolatry. The whole city was filled with sculptured idols. There was a god upon every hilltop.

When Paul arrived in Athens, the intellectual center of the world, he realized that the Lord wanted him to teach the gospel where Greek philosophy reigned supreme. For Paul, these artifacts were not mere artistic objects, but rather they were objects of a pagan religion. In this idolatrous city, Paul was to introduce the gospel of Christ.
