Sermon Title: "UNDERSTANDING THE GREAT COMMISSION" Date: January 21, 2024 - Matthew 28:16-20

Central Idea: Evangelism should be *normal*—in our own lives and in our church. Is it normal for you to share the Good News?

Introduction: Isn't it amazing that we have trouble sharing such wonderful news? God has established who and how we should evangelize. God Himself is at the heart of the *evangel*—the good news we are spreading. Ultimately, we should evangelize because of God.

I. Culture of Evangelism

This means that we have an expectation that Christians will share the gospel with others, talk about doing that, pray about it, and regularly plan and work together to help each other evangelize. We want evangelism to be normal—in our own lives and in our church.

The local church is the normal means God has given us to fulfill the Great Commission.

- 4. Provoke self-reflection
- 5. Use the church
