Sermon Title: THE DAUGHTERS OF JERUSALEM

Date: March 23, 2025 - Luke 23:27-31

Central Idea: God does not permit impenitence to go unpunished. Are you refusing to repent of sin?

Introduction:

Jesus will engage in more conversation before He breathes His last, but these words constitute His final public address.

A large crowd follows the procession as it makes its way to the crucifixion site of the place called "The Skull." Some have come to mock Jesus, but there are others who have come to support Him. The latter are "mourning and lamenting for him" (v. 27). It is a pitiful scene.
