Sermon Title: THE TWO CRIMINALS

Date: March 30, 2025 - Luke 23:32-43

Central Idea: Only the hope of forgiveness can produce repentance. Is your hope in Jesus?

Introduction:

Much in Luke's account of the crucifixion is found only in this Gospel, and a careful comparison of his story with the other three is rewarding. After Peter's denial (22:54-62) came the accusation before Pilate (23:1-7), the appearance before Herod (vv. 8-12), and the judgment of Pilate (vv. 13-25). Then followed the crucifixion (vv. 26-43) and the death of Jesus (vv. 44-49).

 - 1. He confessed his guilt v. 41
 - 2. He recognized Jesus' innocence v. 41
 - 3. He sought mercy v. 42

 - 5. He was given gospel hope v. 43

Conclusion:

The Lord speaks only one line in the entire conversation (v. 43). Put the scenes together:

- Judgment is coming.
- God is forgiving.
- Paradise is offered!
