Central Idea: Christ's death means that redemption makes salvation possible. Are you trusting Christ for your eternal salvation? Introduction:

The crucifixion is set before us in verses 33-49. There are so many factors that enter into the sufferings of the Savior. The atonement is a fact. From God's standpoint, Christ's death meant the manifestation of His righteousness against sin. It also meant the revelation of His love to man.
