TEACHING TRUTH THROUGH CORPORATE WORSHIP

Date: August 3, 2025 - 1 Timothy 3:15; John 17:17

Central Idea: Worship is the holistic response of our lives to the glory of God. Is worship important to you?

Introduction:

The great commission, Matthew 18:19-20, calls us not only to go and make disciples, but also to teach them to obey all that Christ has commanded. The building up of believers happens primarily through the local church where we worship and learn the truth of His Word.

The church should teach and cultivate worship primarily through the following:

- 1. Scripture, 2 Timothy 3:16-17 NIV (Doug Watts)
- 2. Song, Psalm 95:1-2 NIV (Chris Veade)
- 3. Prayer, 2 Chronicles 7:14 NLT (John Fiore)
- 4. Ordinances, Matthew 3:13-17; Luke 22:19-20 NLT (Steve Spruill)
- 5. Stewardship, Romans 12:1; 1 Corinthians 3:3-10 CSB (Pastor Creed)

Conclusion: Hebrews 10:24, 25

"Fellowship with God must never become singular and selfish. We must also fellowship with other Christians in the local assembly. Apparently, some of the wavering believers had been absenting themselves from the church fellowship. Note that the emphasis here is not on what a believer gets from the assembly, but rather on what he or she can contribute to the assembly. Faithfulness in church attendance encourages others and provokes them to love and good works."
